

Resolution No. 154. ✓

To improve Columbia Avenue from the south line of South Commonwealth Avenue to the south line of Maryland Avenue.

Resolved by the Council of the Village of Bexley, State of Ohio:—

(a) That it is necessary to improve Columbia Avenue from the south line of South Commonwealth Avenue to the south line of Maryland Avenue, in said Village, by grading, curbing, paving the roadway with brick, concrete, some form of asphalt or some form of treated macadam, constructing the sewers necessary to furnish proper drainage for such improvement, and constructing water and sewer connections from the water main and the sewer in said Avenue to the inner curb line of said Avenue, in accordance with the plans, specifications, estimates and profiles of said improvement prepared by the engineers of said Village, which plans are hereby approved and filed in the office of the Village Clerk.

(b) That the grade of said Avenue as improved shall be as shown on the plans and profiles to-wit:—

West Curb:— Beginning at the intersection of the west curb of Columbia Avenue with the south line of South Commonwealth Avenue at an elevation of 116.45 Village Datum; thence on a 0.494 per cent ascending grade 350.27 feet to a point of elevation 118.18; thence across the intersection of North Commonwealth Avenue 20 feet to a point of elevation 118.18; thence on a 0.36 per cent ascending grade for 1290.47 feet to a point of elevation 122.83.

East Curb:— The grade of the east curb of Columbia Avenue is the same as that of the west curb.

(c) That the whole cost of said improvement less one-fiftieth ($\frac{1}{50}$) thereof, and the cost of

improvements shall be assessed by the foot front upon the following described lots and lands to-wit: All lots and lands are hereby determined to be specially benefited by said improvement and in amount equal to the cost thereof.

(d) That the assessment so to be levied shall be paid in ten (10) annual installments with interest on deferred payments at a rate not exceeding six per cent (6%) per annum; provided that the owner of any property assessed may, at his option, pay such assessments or any number of installments of the same at any time after such assessment has been levied, with interest to the semi-annual interest day of bonds issued in anticipation of the collection of such assessments next following date of payment.

(e) That bonds of said Village of Bexley, Ohio, shall be issued in anticipation of the collection of assessments by installment and in amount equal thereto.

(f) That the remainder of the entire cost of said improvement, not specially assessed, shall be paid by the issuance of bonds of said Village in the manner provided by law.
