ORDINANCE NO. 158

TO VACATE DAWSON AVENUE FROM BROAD STREET TO MARYLAND AVENUE

WHEREAS on the 12th day of June, 1917, a petition by persons owning all of lots in the immediate vicinity of and abounding and abutting upon Dawson Avenue from Broad Street to Maryland Avenue, was duly presented to Council praying and consenting that said Dawson Avenue between the points named be vacated; and,

WHEREAS, Council upon hearing is satisfied that there is good cause for such vacation as prayed for; that it will not be detrimental to the general interest, and ought to be made, NOW THEREFORE,

Be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Bexley, State of Ohio.

SECTION 1. That Dawson Avenue from Broad Street to Maryland Avenue be and the same hereby is vacated.

SECTION 2. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

AN ORDINANCE 158

To fix the location and width and to establish the grade of sidewalks on Main Street between the east end of the bridge over Alum Creek and the east corporation line on the Village of Bexley.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the sidewalks on both sides of Main Street between the east end of the bridge over Alum Creek and the east corporation line of said village, shall be five (5) feet in width with the inner edge thereof, (that is, the edge farthest from the curb), a distance of nine (9) feet from the face of the stone curb,

SECTION 2. That the grade of said sidewalk shall be what is known as a standard grade, having the inner edge thereof four-tenths ($4/10$) of a foot above the grade of the existing curb and the outer edge on the same grade as the grade of said curb.

SECTION 3. That ordinance No. 153, passed April _____, 1917, entitled an ordinance "to fix the location and width and establish the grade of sidewalks on Main Street between the Alum Creek bridge and the east corporation line," be and the same is hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
