AN ORDINANCE NO. 159

Acceptance 'Stanberry Place' Subdivision

Be it ordained by the council of the Village of Bexley, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the plat The Forest Realty Company's subdivision of lots one (1) to nine (9) inclusive of block four (4) and lots twelve (12) to twenty-three (23) inclusive, block five (5) of the Bullitt Park addition, together with a strip of land forty feet wide extending from Broad Street to Maryland Avenue formerly known as Dawson Avenue and which was duly vacated on June 12, 1917, and a tract of thirty two (32) acres, bounded on the south by Broad Street, on the east by Cassady Avenue, on the north by Maryland Avenue and on the west by said Dawson Avenue as vacated be and the same hereby is approved and accepted. The streets and avenues, not heretofore dedicated, shown on said plat are hereby accepted as public highways and dedicated to public use.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
