

Resolution No. 160. ✓
 Requesting County Commissioners to
 appoint a Board of Education for the Bexley
 School District.

Whereas, at the time of the last election
 of Municipal officers for the Village of Bexley,
 Franklin County, Ohio, the total tax valuation of
 property within said village was in excess of
 Five Hundred Thousand (\$500,000) Dollars, and

Whereas, said village now constitutes a village
 school district, and

Whereas, said village at its last election of
 municipal officers failed to elect a Board of
 Education as provided by section 4709 of the General Code,

Now Therefore, be it resolved by the Council
 of the Village of Bexley, Franklin County, Ohio, that
 the commissioners of said Franklin County be
 and they hereby are requested to appoint a Board
 of Education for said Village school district, to serve
 until their successors are elected and qualified
 as provided by section 4710 of the General Code.

Resolved, further that the clerk of this Council
 be and he hereby is directed to file a certified copy
 of this resolution with the Board of Commissioners
 of Franklin County, Ohio.
