

ORDINANCE NO. 163

PETERMINING TO PROCEED WITH THE IMPROVEMENT OF ASHBOURNE
PLACE IN THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, OHIO

Be it ordained by the council of the Village of Bexley, State of
Ohio:

Section 1. That it is hereby determined to proceed with the
improvement of Ashbourne Place in said Village by grading, curbing and paving
the roadway with brick, asphalt, bitulithic, tarvia, or some other form of
permanent improvement; constructing sewer necessary to furnish proper
drainage for such improvement, and constructing water and sanitary sewer
connections from the water main and sanitary sewer in said avenue to the
lots and lands abutting thereon, in accordance with the resolution declaring
it necessary to improve said avenue adopted by the council of said Village
on the 24th day of July, 1917, and in accordance with the plans, specifications
estimates and profiles of said improvement heretofore approved and now on file
in the office of the clerk of said Village.

Section 2. That all claim for damages resulting therefrom shall
be judicially inquired into after the completion of the proposed improve-
ment, and the village solicitor be and he hereby is authorized and directed
to institute proceedings in a court of competent jurisdiction to inquire into
such claims.

Section 3. That the total cost of said improvement, together with
the interest on bonds issued in anticipation of the collection of assessments
to be levied for said improvement and all other necessary expenditures shall
be assessed in proportion to the special benefits which result from the im-
provement, as petitioned for, by the owners ^{upon} of the following described lots
and lands to-wit: All lots and lands fronting, bounding or abutting upon
said improvement on said ^{Ashbourne Place} ~~avenue~~, which said lots and lands are hereby deter-
mined to be specially benefited by said improvement, and in an amount equal
to the cost thereof.

Section 4. That the assessments so to be levied shall be paid in
Twenty annual installments with interest on deferred payments at a rate not
exceeding 6% per annum; provided, that the owner of any of the property

assessed may, at his option, pay such assessments or any number of the installments thereof, at any time after said assessment has been levied, with interest to the semi-annual interest date of said bonds next following the date of payment.

Section 5. That bonds in the Village of Bexley, Ohio, shall be issued in anticipation of the collection of assessments by installments and in an amount equal thereto.

Section 6. That the clerk of said Village be and he hereby is authorized and directed to advertise for bids for the construction of said improvement according to law.

Section 7. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
