

Resolution No. 166.

Whereas, it has been determined by Council to assess the whole cost, less one-fiftieth ($\frac{1}{50}$) thereof and the cost of intersections, of the improvement on South Drexel Avenue from Main Street to Dale Avenue in proportion to the special benefits which may result from said improvement; and

Whereas an estimated assessment was made before the completion of said improvement and before the cost thereof had been accurately determined; and

Whereas, the improvement has been completed and it is now necessary to make a correct assessment of said cost and expense,

Now Therefore: -

Be it Resolved by the Council of the Village of Besley, State of Ohio;

That Geo. E. Fry, J. E. L. Schmeueckle, and E. D. Barnett, three disinterested freeholders of said Village, be and they are hereby appointed a board to estimate the assessment of such cost on the lots and lands to be charged therewith as set forth in an ordinance No. 78, passed May 25, 1915, in proportion as nearly as may be to the special benefits which may result from said improvement to the several lots or parcels of land so assessed, and to report to this Council the said estimated assessment:
