an ordinance no. 168

To levy special assessments for the construction of sidewalks on the East side of Bryden Road, (formerly Town Street), between Parkview Avenue and Drexel Avenue.

Be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Bexley, State of Ohio:

Section 1. That to pay the cost and expense of constructing sidewalks in front of lots hereinafter described, situated on the East side of
Bryden Road (formerly Town Street) in said Village between Parkview Avenue
and Drexel Avenue, in accordance with a resolution of Council heretofore
adopted, there be levied and assessed upon the following described lots the
several amounts hereinafter set forth, viz:

Section 2. That the owners of the several lots assessed as aforesaid, shall pay the amounts of money from them severally due in that behalf to the Village Treasurer within ten days after the date of the final passage of this ordinance, and if not so paid the assessments shall be certified to the county auditor, to be placed upon the tax duplicate and collected with a penalty of five per cent (5%) as provided by law.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
