Ohio, within the period of thirty days from the date of the final periods of this ordinince, or at the option of the owner, in twenty annual installments with interest at the rate of the period of the owner, in twenty annual installments with interest at the rate of the per annual upon deferred payments, at the office of the treasurer of Franklin County, Onic, after the same has been cartified to the county auditor for collection in the manner provided by law. Said assessments, after being so certified, may be paid in full or any number of annual installments may be that at any tax collection time, with interest on the same to the semi-annual interest day next ersuing to wit, October first and April first. If said installments of coald assessments are not paid when the same become due, a penalty will be imposed and collected, as provided by law.

SECTION 3. That said assessments and all portions thereof when collected shall be paid into the sinking fund and shall be applied to the payment of the bonds issued for said improvement and the interest thereon as the same shall become due, and to no other purpose whatsoever.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
