

AN ORDINANCE NO. 173

BY MR. A. C. Wolfe

To levy special assessments for the improvement of North Commonwealth Avenue from Parkview Avenue to Drexel Avenue.

Be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Bexley, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That to pay that portion of the cost and expense heretofore determined to be specially assessed for the improvement of North Commonwealth Avenue from Parkview Avenue to Drexel Avenue, by grading, curbing and paving the roadway, constructing sewers necessary to furnish proper drainage for such improvement, and constructing water and sanitary sewer connections from the water main and sanitary sewer in said Avenue to the lots and lands fronting and abutting thereon, there be levied and assessed upon the lots and lands hereinafter described the several amounts hereinafter set forth, to-wit:

which assessments are at the rate of \$3.704765 per front foot of the property assessed.

SECTION 2. That the total assessments shall be payable at the office of the treasurer of the Village of Bexley, Ohio, within the period of thirty days from the date of the final passage of this ordinance, or at the option of the owner, in twenty annual installments with interest at the rate of 5 % per annum upon deferred payments, at the office of the treasurer of Franklin County, Ohio, after the same has been certified to the county auditor for collection in the manner provided by law. Said assessments, after being so certified, may be paid in full or any number of annual installments may be paid at

any tax collection time, with interest on the same to the semi-annual interest day next ensuing, to-wit, October first and April first. If said installments of said assessments are not paid when the same become due, a penalty will be imposed and collected, as provided by law.

SECTION 3. That said assessments and all portions thereof when collected shall be paid into the sinking fund and shall be applied to the payment of the bonds issued for said improvement and the interest thereon as the same shall become due, and to no other purpose whatsoever.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
