AN ORDINANCE NO. 174

To levy Special Assessments for the improvement of Drexel Avenue from the North line of Main Street to Dale Avenue by grading, curbing, paving the roadway, constructing the sewers necessary to furnish proper drainage for such improvement and constructing water and sewer connections from the water main and sewer in said Avenue, and to repeal Ordinance No. 100, passed on the 23rd day of October, 1915.

Be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Bexley, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the assessment of the cost and expense of improving Drexel Avenue from the North line of Main Street to Dale Avenue in said Village by grading, curbing, paving the roadway with brick, constructing sewers necessary to furnish proper drainage for such improvement and constructing water and sewer connections from the water main and sewer in said Avenue, to the inner line of the curbs on said Avenue, as reported to Council on the 2nd day of October, 1917, by the Board heretofore appointed to estimate said assessment, be and the same is hereby adopted, and that there be and hereby is levied and assessed upon the lots and lands hereinafter described the several amounts herein set forth:

It is hereby determined and declared that each of said lots and lands are specially benefited by said improvement in an amount equal to said assessment.

SECTION 2. That the total assessment shall be payable at the office of the Treasurer of the Village of Bexley, Ohio, within a period of Thirty (30) days from the date of the first publication of this Ordinance, with interest at the rate of Five (5) Per Cent per annum from the 1st day of October, 1915, or at the option of the owner in ten annual installments with interest at the rate of Five (5) Per Cent per annum upon deferred payments at the office of the Treasurer of Franklin County, Ohio, after the same has been certified to the County Auditor for collection in the manner provided by law. The said assessment after being so certified may, however, be paid in full or in any number of annual installments at any tax collection time, with interest on the same to the semi-annual interest day next ensuing. If said installments of said assessment are not paid when the same become due, a penalty will be imposed

and collected as provided by law.

SECTION 3. That said assessment and all portions thereof when collected shall be paid into the Sinking Fund and shall be applied to the payment of the bonds issued for said improvement and the interest thereof as the same shall become due and to no other purpose whatsoever.

SECTION 4. That an Ordinance ~~entitled~~ entitled "An Ordinance to levy special assessments for the improvement of Drexel Avenue from the North line of Main Street to Dale Avenue," etc. No. 100, passed on the 23rd day of October, 1915, be and the same hereby is repealed.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
