

An Ordinance No. 178.

By Mr. Wolfe

To fix the Salaries of the Members of the Board of
trustees of Public Affairs.

Be it ordained by the Council of the Village of
Boxley, Ohio:

Section 1. That the Members of the Board of Trustees
of Public Affairs shall each receive a salary or compensation of
Two Dollars (\$2.00) per meeting and shall be allowed compensation
for not more than two meetings per month and shall be entitled to
compensation only for such meetings as he attends.

Section 2. That Ordinance No. 164, adopted January 11,
1916, and Section 2 of Ordinance No. 45, adopted December 9, 1913
be and the same are hereby repealed.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in
force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
