Irvine be and hereby is employed to act as attorney for the Village in the case of Forrest Realty Co vs. The Village of Bexley Ohio, pending in the Court of Common Pleas of Franklin County Ohio, and that his compensation shall be ten dollars per day for office work in the preparation of the case for trial and \$5.00 per day for Court work, with the understanding that the property owners on Cassidy Avenue furnish counsel to assist in the preparation and trial of said cause.
