

ORDINANCE NO. 1823

TO APPROVE THE PLAT OF BEXLEY PLACE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That C. R. McLaughlin's plat of Bexley Place, being a subdivision of 6.68 feet off the south side of Lot three (3) and all of Lot two (2) except a strip 15 feet by 747 feet out of the southeast corner thereof, of Joseph Rudolph's heirs partition, as the same is shown of record in plat book 7, page 168, Recorder's Office, Franklin County, Ohio, be and the same hereby is approved; and that all of the streets and alleys shown on said plat, not heretofore dedicated to public use, hereby are accepted and the dedication thereof to public use as highways hereby is confirmed.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
