

Resolution # 182 ✓

Declaring it necessary to issue and sell bonds of the village of Bexley, Franklin County, Ohio, for the purpose of paying the village's portion of the cost and expense of improving sundry streets and avenues in said village by grading, paving and constructing sewers necessary to furnish the proper drainage for such improvements and providing for the submission of the question of issuing such bonds to a vote of the electors of said village.

Be it resolved by the council of the village of Bexley, State of Ohio, (two thirds of all the members elected and appointed thereto and concurring) that it is necessary to issue and sell the bonds of said village in the sum of \$2500.00 for the purpose of paying the village's portion of the cost and expense of improving certain of the streets and avenues of said village, by grading, paving, and constructing sewers necessary to furnish proper drainage for such improvements, to-wit:

South Commonwealth Avenue from Parkview Avenue to Columbia Avenue.

Be it resolved further that the question of issuing and selling the bonds of said village for said purposes, in the sum aforesaid, be submitted to a vote of the qualified electors of said village at the general election to be held in said village on the (fifth) day of November, 1918, at the regular place of voting in said village, and said election shall be canvassed and certified in the same manner as other municipal elections.

That the mayor be and he by is directed to give the proper notice of the time and place of holding said election in the manner provided by law.

That the clerk be and hereby is directed
to certify a copy of this resolution to the
Deputy State Supervisors of Elections, of
Franklin County, Ohio.
