

AN ORDINANCE NO. 190

DETERMINING TO PROCEED WITH THE CONSTRUCTION OF A PART OF THE SEWERS SHOWN
UPON THE PLAN OF SEWER DISTRICT NO. 2

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Bexley, State of
Ohio -

Section 1. That it is hereby determined to proceed with the con-
struction of that part of the sewers shown upon the plan of Sewer District No.
2 within said village described as follows:

The main sewer shown upon the plan of said district,
commencing in Parkview Avenue at a point 200 feet north of the
center line of Maryland Avenue; thence north in Parkview Avenue
971 feet to the center line of Caroline Avenue at a point 110
feet west of the center line of the first alley east of said Park-
view Avenue running north from Caroline Avenue; thence east in said
Caroline Avenue 761 feet to a manhole in said avenue at a point
opposite the center line of the first alley west of Drexel Avenue
running north from Caroline Avenue,

pursuant to a resolution adopted by the council of said village on the
25th day of June, 1918, and in accordance with the plans
and specifications heretofore prepared by the engineer of said village for a
system of sewerage in said district, adopted by council on the 11th day of June,
1918, and now on file in the office of the clerk of said village, and to be con-
structed of vitrified sewer pipe.

Section 2. That the cost of said improvement, less one-fiftieth
(1/50) thereof, and the cost of intersections, shall be assessed in proportion
to the benefits which may result from said improvement upon the following
described lots and lands, to-wit:

All of the lots and lands in said Sewer District No. 2 which are not
already provided with adequate local drainage, and said lots and lands are here-

by determined to be specially benefited by said improvement; that one-fiftieth (1/50) of the cost of said improvement and the cost of intersections shall be paid by the village out of the sewer funds.

Section 3. That the assessments so to be levied shall be paid to the village treasurer in two installments - the first within thirty days after the passage of the assessment ordinance, and the second within six months after the expiration of said thirty day period, with interest on the deferred payment at six per cent. (6%) per annum, provided that the owner of any property assessed may, at his option, pay all such assessment in cash within thirty days after the passage of the assessment ordinance.

Section 4. That the clerk be, and he is hereby authorized and directed to advertise for bids for the construction of said improvement according to law.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
