

Resolution No. 190. ✓

Declaring it necessary to issue and sell bonds of the Village of Bexley, Ohio, for the purpose of paying the village's part of the cost of improving streets in said village.

Be it resolved by the council of the village of Bexley, Ohio, two-thirds of all the members elected and appointed thereto concurring, that it is necessary to issue and sell bonds of said village in the sum of \$17,000⁰⁰ for the purpose of paying the village's part of the cost and expense of improving sundry streets and avenues in said village, by grading, curbing, paving the roadway, constructing sewers necessary to furnish proper drainage for such improvements and making water and sanitary sewer connections from the water mains and sanitary sewers in said streets and avenues to the lots and lands fronting thereon at the inner curb line of streets and avenues, to wit:

Tarkview Avenue from a point two hundred (200) feet north from the center line of Maryland Ave. to the south line of Carolina Ave.; Dawson Ave. from Fair Ave. to Broad Street; Broad St. from west-corporation line to a point two hundred (200) ft. east of the east line of Cassidy Ave.; and Bullitt Park Place
