

Resolution No. 191. ✓

Declaring it necessary to issue and sell bonds of the village of Bexley, Ohio, for the purpose of paying a part of the cost of constructing sewers in said village.

Be it Resolved by the Council of the village of Bexley, Ohio, two-thirds of all the members elected and appointed thereto concurring, that it is necessary to issue and sell bonds of said village in the sum of \$45,000⁰⁰ for the purpose of paying a part of the cost and expenses of constructing sewers in said village.

Be it Resolved further that the question of issuing and selling said bonds for purpose, and in the sum aforesaid, be submitted to a vote of the qualified electors of said village at a special election to be held in said village, at the regular voting place, on the 1st day of May, 1919; that the Mayor be and he hereby is directed to give public notice of the time and place of holding said election in the manner provided by law; that the clerk be and he hereby is directed to certify a copy of this resolution to the Deputy State Supervisors of Elections of Franklin County, Ohio.
