

Resolution No. 192. ✓

By Mrs. Cooke:

Declaring It Necessary to Improve Parkview Ave. from a Point Two Hundred Feet North of the Center line of Maryland Ave. to the south line of Caroline Ave.

Be It Resolved by the Council of the Village of Berley, State of Ohio, three fourths of all members elected and appointed thereto concurring:

Section I That it is necessary to improve Parkview Ave. in said Village from a point two hundred feet north of the center line of Maryland Ave. to the south line of Caroline Ave. by grading, curbing, paving the roadway with brick, concrete, some form of asphalt or some form of treated macadam, constructing sewers necessary to furnish proper drainage for such improvement, and constructing water and sewer connections from the water mains and sanitary sewer in said Parkview Ave. to the inner line of the curbs on said avenue, in accordance with the plans, specifications, estimates and profiles of said proposed improvement, prepared by the engineers of said village and on file in the office of the clerk of said village, which plans, specifications, estimates and profiles are hereby approved.

Section II That the grade of said avenue as improved shall be the same as shown upon the plans and profiles to-wit:

East Curb: Beginning at a point in the proposed curb line of Parkview Ave. 200 ft. north of the center line of Maryland Ave. said beginning point being designated as Station 73 plus 96.9 and having an elevation of 120.50 ft. Village Datum; thence from said beginning point north with an 0.30 per cent ascending grade 920.1 ft. to a point in the south line of Caroline Ave. at an elevation of 117.74 ft.

West Curb: Beginning at a point in the proposed curb line of Parkview Ave. 200 ft. north of the center line of Maryland Ave., said beginning point being designated as Station 73 plus 96.9 and having an elevation of 120.50 ft. Village Datum; thence from said beginning point north with an 0.30 per cent ascending grade 920.1 ft. to a point in the south line of Caroline Ave. at an elevation of 117.74 ft.

Section III That the whole cost of said improvement, less one-fiftieth thereof and the cost of intersection shall be assessed by the front foot upon the following described lots and lands, to-wit: All lots + lands fronting, bounding and abutting upon the proposed improvement, which said lots and lands are hereby determined to be specially

benefited by said improvement, and in amount equal to that portion of the cost of said improvement hereby determined to be assessed thereon.

Section III That the assessment so to be levied shall be paid in ten annual installments, with interest on deferred payments at a rate not exceeding six per cent per annum.

Section IV That the bonds of said village shall be issued in anticipation of the collection of the assessments by installments, and in an amount equal thereto.

Section V That the remainder of the cost of said improvement shall be paid by the issuance of bonds of the village in the manner provided by law.
