ORDINANCE NO. 195

By Mr. Deenlap

TO PROHIBIT SLAUGHTER HOUSES WITHIN THE VILLAGE
OF
BEXLEY, OHIO.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Bexley,
Ohio, as follows:

Section 1. That the maintenance of slaughter houses,
the slaughtering of meat, animals, and the rendering of fats within
the corporate limit of said Village constitute a public nuisance,
~~and are thereby declared to be unlawful.~~

Section 2. That it shall be unlawful for any person,
firm or corporation to operate a slaughter house, or in any way to
assist in carrying on the business of slaughtering meat, animals, or
the rendering of fats within the corporate limits of said Village;
and, any person or persons violating the provisions of this Ordinance
shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof
shall be fined in any sum not less than Twenty-five Dollars nor more
than One Hundred Dollars for each offense, and each day any such slaughter
house is maintained or said business is carried on shall constitute a
separate offense.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in
force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
