

Resolution No. 195

Declaring It Necessary To Improve Bexley Ave
From Dawson Ave. To Cassidy Ave.

Resolved, by the council of the village of Bexley, state of Ohio, three fourths of all members concurring:

Section I: That it is necessary to improve Bexley Avenue from Dawson Ave to Cassidy Ave in said village by grading, curbing, paving the roadway with brick, concrete, bitulithic, some form of asphalt or some form of treated macadam, constructing the sewers necessary to furnish the proper drainages for such improvement, and constructing water and sewer connections from the water main and sanitary sewer in said avenue to the inner line of the curbs on said avenue, in accordance with the plans, specifications, estimates and profiles of said proposed improvement prepared by the engineer of the village, which plans are hereby approved.

Section II: That the grade of said Avenue as improved shall be as shown on the plans and profiles to-wit:

North Curb: Beginning at a point in the proposed north curb line of Bexley Avenue and in the east line of Dawson Ave, said beginning point being designated as Station 0 and having an elevation of 110.10 ft. Village Datum; thence from said beginning point easterly with a .37% ascending grade 450 ft. to Sta. 4 plus 50 elevation 111.45 ft; thence easterly with a descending grade 100.16 ft. to Sta. 5 plus 50.16 elevation 111.15 ft; said last named point being in the east line of Cassidy Ave;

South Curb: Beginning at a point in the proposed north curb line of Bexley Avenue and in the east line of Dawson Ave, said beginning point being designated as Sta. 0 and having an elevation of 110.10 ft. Village Datum; thence from said beginning point easterly with a .37% ascending grade 450 ft. to Sta. 4 plus 50 elevation 111.45 ft; thence easterly with a descending grade 100.16 ft. to Sta. 5 plus 50.16 elevation 111.15 ft; said last named point being in the east line of Cassidy Ave.

Section III: That the whole cost of said improvement, less one-fiftieth thereof and the cost of intersections, shall be assessed

by the foot front upon the following described lots and lands to-wit: All lots and lands bounding and abutting upon the proposed improvement, which said lots and lands are hereby determined to be specially benefited by said improvement, and in an amount equal to the part of the cost hereby determined to be assessed thereon.


Section IV. That the assessments so to be levied shall be paid in ten annual installments, with interest on deferred payments at a rate not exceeding six per cent per annum.

Section V. That bonds of said village of Bexley, O., shall be issued in anticipation of collection of the assessments by installments, and in an amount equal thereto.

Section VI. That the remainder of the entire cost of said improvement shall be paid by the issuance of bonds of the village in the manner provided by law.
