

## Resolution No. 197

By Mr. Cooke:

Resolution Appointing Board to Report An  
Estimated Assessment to Pay the Cost  
And Expense of Improving Bullitt  
Park Place.

Whereas: it has been determined by the council to assess the whole cost less one-fifth thereof and the cost of intersection, of the improvement of Bullitt Park Place from the north line of Berley Ave. to the improved roadway of Broad St. in proportion to the benefits which may result from said improvement.

Now, therefore;

Be It Resolved by the Council of the Village of Berley, State of Ohio, that G. T. Wanamaker, J. F. Elder, and J. C. McVey, three disinterested freeholders of said village, be and they are hereby appointed a board to estimate the assessment of such costs on the lots + lands to be charged there-with as set forth in Ordinance No. to improve said Avenue, passed on the 13<sup>th</sup> day of May 1919 in proportion as nearly as may be to the benefits which may result from the improvement to the several lots + parcels of land so assessed, and to report to this council the said estimated assessment.
