AN ORDINANCE NO. 199

DETERMINING TO PROCEED WITH THE IMPROVEMENT OF PARKVIEW AVENUE FROM A POINT 200 FEET NORTH OF THE CENTER LINE OF MARYLAND AVENUE TO TO THE SOUTH LINE OF CAROLINE AVENUE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO, to-wit:

SECTION 1. That it is hereby determined to proceed with the improvement of Parkview Avenue in said village from a point 200 feet north of the center line of Maryland Avenue to the south line of Caroline Avenue by grading, curbing, paving the roadway with brick, concrete, some form of asphalt or some form of treated macadam, constructing sewers necessary to furnish proper drainage for such improvement and constructing water and sewer connections from the water main and sanitary sewer in said Parkview Avenue to the inner line of the curbs on said Avenue, in accordance with the plans, specifications, estimates and profiles of said proposed improvements, heretofore approved and now on file in the office of the clerk of said village and in pursuance of the resolution declaring it necessary to improve said avenue, adopted by the council of said relage on the 8th may of April, 1919.

SECTION 2. That all claims for damages resulting from such improvement shall be judicially inquired into a rather completion thereof, and the village collicitor be and he haveby is authorized and directed to institute proceedings in a court of competent jurisdiction to inquire into such claims.

SECTION 3. That the whole cost of said improvement less one-fiftieth (1/50) thereof and the cost of intersection shall be assessed by the front foot upon the following described lots and lands, to-wit:

All lots and lands for sting, bounding and abutting upon said proposed improvement, which said lots and lands are hereby determined to be specially benefitted by said improvement and in an amount equal to that portion of the cost thereof hereby determined to be aspessed thereon.

SECTION 4. That two sum of \$ 1600,00 be and the same is hereby

and related from the improvement and intersection fund to pay the remainder of the cost of said improvement.

SECTION 5. That the assessments so to be levied shall be paid in ten annual installments, with interest an deferred payments at a rate not exceeding 6% per annum.
