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AN ORDINANCE NO. 204

DETERMINING TO PROCEED WITH THE IMPROVEMENT OF BEXLEY AVENUE FROM
DAWSON AVENUE TO CASSADY AVENUE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO, to-wit:

SECTION 1. That it is hereby determined to proceed with the improvement of Bexley Avenue in said village from Dawson Avenue to Cassady Avenue by grading, curbing, paving the roadway with brick, concrete, some form of asphalt or some form of treated macadam, constructing sewers necessary to furnish proper drainage for such improvement and constructing water and sewer connections from the water main and sanitary sewer in said Bexley Avenue to the inner line of the curbs on said Avenue, in accordance with the plans, specifications, estimates and profiles of said proposed improvements, heretofore approved and now on file in the office of the clerk of said village and in pursuance of the resolution declaring it necessary to improve said Avenue, adopted by the council of said village on the 8th day of April, 1919.

SECTION 2. That all claims for damages resulting from such improvement shall be judicially inquired into after the completion thereof, and the village solicitor be and he hereby is authorized and directed to institute proceedings in a court of competent jurisdiction to inquire into such claims.

SECTION 3. That the whole cost of said improvement less one-fiftieth (1/50) thereof and the cost of intersections shall be assessed by the front foot upon the following described lots and lands, to-wit:

All lots and lands fronting, bounding and abutting upon said proposed improvement, which said lots and lands are hereby determined to be specially benefited by said improvement and in an amount equal to that portion of the cost thereof hereby determined to be assessed thereon.

SECTION 4. That the sum of \$ 1300⁰⁰ be and the same is hereby appropriated from the improvement and intersection fund to pay the remainder of the cost of said improvement.

SECTION 5. That the assessments so to be levied shall be paid in ten annual installments, with interest on deferred payments at a rate not exceeding 6% per annum.

SECTION 6. That bonds of said village shall be issued in anticipation of the collection of the assessments by installments and in an amount equal thereto.

SECTION 7. That the clerk of said village be and he hereby is authorized and directed to advertise for bids for the construction of said improvement according to law.

SECTION 8. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
