

Resolution No. 204

Declaring it Necessary to Construct sanitary Sewer on the South Side of Broad Street from the Sewer in Casady Avenue to Remington Road.

Be it Resolved by the Council of the Village of Pexley, State of Ohio: That it is necessary to construct a sanitary sewer in the south side of Broad Street in said village from the sewer in Casady Avenue eastwardly to Remington Road.

Resolved, Further, that said sewer shall be constructed of vitrified sewer pipe in accordance with the plans and specifications prepared by the engineers of said village and on file in the office of the clerk.

Resolved, Further, that the whole cost of constructing said sewer and any and all necessary expenses connected therewith shall be assessed by the foot frontage upon all the lots and lands fronting and abutting upon the south side of said Broad Street between Casady Avenue and Remington Road, which said lots and lands are hereby determined to be specially benefited by said improvement, and fix an amount equal to the cost thereof.

Resolved, Further, that the assessment so to be levied shall be paid in one installment within thirty days after passage of the assessment ordinance.

Resolved, Further, that this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest

period allowed by law.
