

AN ORDINANCE NO. 207

BY MR. Cook

TO PROVIDE FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF BROAD STREET FROM THE WEST CORPORATION LINE TO A POINT 200 FEET EAST ON CASSIDY AVENUE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO, to-wit:

SECTION 1. That Broad Street from the west corporation line to a point 200 feet east of Cassidy Avenue in said village shall be improved by repairing the roadway and covering the same with a bituminous surface treatment, in accordance with plans, specifications and estimates prepared by the engineers of said village and on file in the office of the clk.

SECTION 2. That the cost of said improvement shall be paid from the proceeds of bonds authorized to be issued by a vote of the electors of said village at a special election held at the regular voting place in said village on the first day of May, 1919.

SECTION 3. That the sum of \$ 4500 be and the same hereby is appropriated from the street improvement and intersection fund to pay the cost of said improvement.

SECTION 4. That the clerk of said village be and he hereby is authorized and directed to advertise for bids for the making of said improvement according to law.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
