AN ORDINANCE NO. 225

TO REQUIRE THE COLUMBUS RAILWAY, LIGHT AND POWER COMPANY TO RE-
CONSTRUCT ITS TRACKS IN DAWSON AVENUE FROM WALNUT AVENUE TO
BROAD STREET AND TO CONFORM THEM TO THE GRADE ESTABLISHED
FOR THE PERMANENT IMPROVEMENT OF SAID AVENUE

WHEREAS, the council of the village of Bexley, Ohio, on the 26th day of August, 1919, duly adopted a resolution declaring it necessary to improve Dawson Avenue from Fair Avenue to Broad Street by grading, curbing and paving the roadway with brick, concrete, bitulithic, some form of asphalt or some form of treated macadam; and

WHEREAS, there is located in said Dawson Avenue between Walnut Avenue and Broad Street, the rails, ties, roadbed and tracks of a street railway owned and operated by said The Columbus Railway, Light and Power Company which have become worn out and defective; and

WHEREAS, in order to improve the roadway of said Avenue, as aforesaid, it is necessary that the grade of said tracks be made to conform to the grade of said Dawson Avenue, as established for the improvement thereof by the resolution declaring the necessity for such improvement, adopted as aforesaid.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO, that it is necessary to require said The Columbus Railway, Light and Power Company to reconstruct its roadbed, ties and tracks in said Dawson Avenue between the points aforesaid at the time said Avenue is torn up for the making of the improvement of the roadway thereof, as aforesaid.

BE IT RESOLVED, FURTHER, that said The Columbus Railway, Light and Power Company be and hereby is ordered to reconstruct its roadbed, ties and tracks in said Avenue, in accordance with the plans and specifications prepared by the Chief Engineer of said Village, which plans and specifications, together with the Engineer's estimate of the cost of labor and materials necessary for such reconstruction, are on file in the office of said Engineer and open to public inspection.

BE IT RESOLVED, FURTHER, that the Village Clerk shall send by registered mail to said The Columbus Railway, Light and Power Company a certified copy of this resolution, together with a written notice setting forth the time and place at which a hearing will be given said company, at which time said company may be present to make any objection to this resolution.

RESOLVED, FURTHER, that this resolution shall take effect and be
in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
