AN ORDINANCE NO.

TO FIX COMPENSATION AND BONDS OF THE OFFICERS CLERKS AND EMPLOYES OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY AND TO REPEAL ORDINANCE NO. 103, PASSED DECEMBER 28, 1915, AND ALL OTHER ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES HERETOFORE PASSED AND INCONSISTENT HEREWITH

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, OHIC, as follows, to-wit:

SECTION 1. That the compensation of the mayor of said village shall be the sum of \$ /00 00 per annum in addition to all fees and other compensation now or hereafter provided by law, and he shall give bond in the sum of \$500. SECTION 2. That the compensation of the clerk of said village shall be per annum, and the compensation of a deputy clerk shall be per annum. Both the clerk and deputy clerk shall give bond in the sum of \$500 each. SECTION 3. That the compensation of the treasurer of said village shall be the sum of \$ 100 " per annum, and he shall give bend in the sum of 2500 SECTION 4. That the compensation of the solicitor of said village shall be \$ 700000 per annum for services rendered to the village, village officials and the Board of Trustees of Public Affairs of said village, provided, however, said solicitor shall not be required to render any service to the village officers or the Board of Trustees of Public Affairs in any litigation or threatened litigation to which said village, officers, or Board may be a party, for the compensation aforesaid, but in case his services shall be required by said village, officers, or board in any case or cases wherein the village, officers, or said board is involved or threatened with litigation, he shall receive for such services such sum or sums as may be agreed upon by such solicitor and the council of said village. The solicitor shall give bond in the sum of \$500. SECTION 5. The compensation of the clerk of the Board of Trustees of Public Affairs of said village shall be \$ 1000 per annum, and he shall give bond in the sum of \$_____ SECTION 6. The compensation of the marshall of said village shall be the sum of \$ 5000 per annum in addition to such fees as are allowed by law, and he shall give bend in the sum of \$500.

members of council of said village shall be paid quarterly, except the compensation of the clerk, deputy clerk, the clerk of the Board of Trustees of Public Affairs, street commissioner, assistant to the Street Commissioner and Village Solicitor, which shall be paid monthly out of the village treasury after the same becomes due. The compensation of other employes, whether of the street commissioner or the Board of Trustees of Public Affairs, shall be paid weekly upon vouchers approved by the Street Commissioner, or the clerk of the Board of Trustees of Public Affairs. The clerk and treasurer are hereby authorized and directed to pay the compensation of said village officers and members of council when due, as herein provided, without other or further action by this council.

SECTION 10. That ordinance No. 103, passed December 28, 1915, and any and all other ordinances inconsistent or in conflict with the provisions hereof be and the same hereby are repealed.

SECTION 11. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
