

Resolution # 213

Declaring it necessary to issue and sell bonds of the Village of Bexley, Ohio, for the purpose of paying the village's part of the cost of improving streets.

Be it resolved by the Council of the Village of Bexley Ohio, two-thirds of all the members elected thereto concurring, that it is necessary to issue and sell bonds of said village in the sum of \$25,000.00 for the purpose of paying the village's part of the cost and expense of improving sundry streets and avenues in said village, to-wit: Cassady Ave. from Brentwood Road to the improved roadway of Broad Street, and Carrolaine Ave. from Main Street to Livingston Ave. by grading, curbing and paving the same, by constructing sewers necessary to furnish proper drainage for such improvements, constructing sanitary sewers and water lines therein, and making sanitary sewer and water constructions from such sewers and water lines to the lots and lands fronting and abutting upon such streets and avenues at the inner line of the curb; and for the purpose of repairing Broad St. from Alum Creek to Cassady Avenue and Cassady Ave. from Broad St. to the Baltimore and Ohio Tracks.

Be it resolved further, that the question of issuing and selling bonds for the purpose and in the sum aforesaid be submitted to a vote of the qualified electors of said village at a special election to be held at the regular voting place in said village on the 27th day of April 1920; that the mayor be and here by is directed to give public notice of the time and place of holding such election, in the manner provided by law; and that the clerk be and hereby is directed to certify a copy of this resolution to the Deputy State Supervisors of Elections of Franklin Co. Ohio
