

Resolution #215

Declaring it necessary to issue and sell bonds of the Village of Besley, Ohio, for the purpose of paying the cost of constructing sanitary sewers.

Be it Resolved by the Council of the Village of Besley, Ohio, two-thirds of all the members elected thereto concurring, that it is necessary to issue and sell bonds of said village in the sum of \$10,000.00 for the purpose of paying the cost of constructing sanitary sewers in said village.

Be it further resolved that the question of issuing and selling such bonds for said purpose, and in the sum aforesaid be submitted to a vote of the qualified electors of said village at a special election to be held at the regular voting place in said village on the 27th day of April; that the mayor be and hereby is directed to give public notice of the time and place of holding said election in the manner provided by Law; that the clerk of the village be and he hereby is directed to certify a copy of this resolution to the Deputy State Superintendant of Elections of Franklin County, Ohio.
