

Resolution # 210 ✓

By Mr. A. W. Legg:

Declaring it necessary to issue and sell bonds of the Village of Bexley, Ohio, for the purpose of paying cost of erecting a building for a fire department and purchasing the necessary equipment for the same.

Be it resolved by the Council of the Village of Bexley, Ohio, two-thirds of all the members elected thereto concurring, that it is necessary to issue and sell bonds of said village in the sum of \$25,000.00 for the purpose of providing money to pay the cost of erecting a building necessary for a fire department, and purchasing the necessary equipment for same.

Be it resolved further that the question of issuing and selling such bonds for said purpose, and in the sum aforesaid be submitted to a vote of the qualified electors of said village at a special election to be held at the regular voting place in the said village on the 27th day of April; that the mayor be and hereby is directed to give public notice of the time and place of holding said election in the manner provided by law; that the clerk of the village be and he hereby is directed to certify a copy of this resolution to the Deputy State Supervisors of Elections of Franklin County, Ohio.

Notice of Election to Issue Bonds.

Notice is hereby given that in pursuance of four certain resolutions of the council of the village of Bexley, Ohio, adopted March 16th, 1920, there will be submitted to the qualified electors of said village, at a special election to be held on the 27th day of April, 1920, at the regular voting place in said village, the question of issuing the bonds of said village in the several amounts and for the purposes following, to-wit: In the sum of \$15,000.00 for the purpose of providing money to pay the cost of constructing water lines in said village; in the sum of \$10,000.00 for the purpose of providing money to pay the cost of constructing sanitary sewers in said village; in the sum of \$25,000.00 for the purpose of providing money to pay the cost of erecting a building for a fire department and purchasing the necessary equipment for the same, and in the sum of \$25,000.00 for the purpose of providing money to pay the village's share of the cost of improving Cassady Avenue from Brentwood Road to Broad Street and Euclair Avenue from Main Street to Livingston Avenue, and for the purpose of repairing Broad Street from Alum Creek to Cassady Avenue and Cassady Avenue from Broad Street to the Baltimore and Ohio tracks.

Those who vote in favor of the proposition of issuing bonds, as aforesaid, shall have written or printed on their ballots the words "For Issue of Bonds," and those who vote against the same shall have written or printed on their ballots the words "Against the Issue of Bonds."
