

Resolution 221

Declaring it necessary to improve Euclaire Avenue from  
Main Street to Livingston Avenue

Whereas the owners of more than 3/4 of the property  
frontage and abutting upon Euclaire between Main Street  
and Livingston Avenue have filed their written petition  
with the council of said village praying said council  
to pass necessary legislation thereof and to improve said  
Euclaire Avenue between the points above named by  
grading, curbing, and paving the roadway with brick  
or asphalt, bitulithic, tarsia, concrete or some other form  
of permanent improvement, constructing sewers necessary  
to furnish proper drainage for such improvements  
and laying water mains in said avenue and making  
water connections to the lots and lands fronting and  
abutting thereon and further petition that the entire  
cost of said improvement except when such portion as is  
by law chargeable against the municipality be assessed  
in proportion to benefits upon the lots and lands bounding  
on said avenue between the above named points.

Now therefore:

Be it resolved by the council of the Village of Berkeley that  
it is necessary to improve Euclaire Avenue  
from Main Street to Livingston Avenue by grading, curbing  
and paving the roadway with brick, asphalt, bitulithic  
tarsia, concrete or some other form of permanent improvement,  
laying water mains in said avenue and making  
water connections to the lots and lands fronting and  
abutting thereon in accordance with the plans and specifications  
estimated and profiles of said proposed improvement prepared by  
the engineer of said village which plans are hereby  
approved and filed.

That the grade of said avenue as improved shall be as  
shown on the plans and profiles aforesaid and the grade  
of the curbs shall be as follows to-wit:  
First grading on the East Side of Euclaire Ave from the North line of Livingston Ave to the south  
line of Main St commencing at the north line of Livingston Ave at Sta. 0+30 at elevation  
95.12 thence with a 2.40% ascending grade to the center of Charles St. Station 1+20. Elevation  
95.28 thence with a 0.30% ascending grade to Sta. 18+00 elevation 98.12 thence on a .3%  
descending grade to the center of Mount St. Sta. 26+03.63 elevation 95.87 thence with a  
.886% ascending grade to the South line of Main St. Sta. 33+00.47 elevation 101.0  
West curb the same. Vertical curves to be used at all breaks in the grade.
