

Ordinance No. 266.

TO LEVY SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS OF THE COST OF CONSTRUCTING A MAIN SEWER IN SEWER DISTRICT NUMBER TWO AND TO REPEAL ORDINANCE NUMBER 266 PASSED APRIL 27th, 1930.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Drexley, Ohio: Section 1. That the assessment of the cost and expense of constructing that part of the sewer shown upon the plan of Sewer District Number Two in said village, to-wit: the main sewer shown upon the plan of Sewer District Number Two commencing in Parkview Avenue at a point 200 feet north of the center line of Maryland Avenue; thence north in Parkview Avenue 271 feet to the center line of Caroline Avenue at a point 110 feet east of the first alley east of Parkview Avenue; thence east in Caroline 101 feet to a man hole, as reported to council on the 23rd day of March, 1930, by the Board heretofore appointed to estimate said assessment, by and the same is adopted and that there be and hereby is levied and assessed upon the lots and lands hereinafter described the several amounts herein set forth, to-wit:

It is hereby determined and declared that each of said lots and lands are specially benefited by said improvement in an amount equal to said assessment.

Section 2. That the assessment hereby levied shall be paid to the treasurer of said village in two equal installments, the first within thirty days after the passage of this ordinance, and the second within six months after the expiration of said thirty day period, with interest on the deferred payments at six per cent (6%) per annum, provided that the owner of any property may, at his option, pay the entire amount of such assessments within thirty days after the passage of this ordinance.

If said assessments are not paid, when and as herein provided, the same shall be certified to the County Auditor and placed upon the tax duplicate for collection, as other taxes, with interest and a penalty as provided by law.

Section 3. That ordinance Number 236 passed April 27th, 1920, be and the same is repealed.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

AN ORDINANCE.

TO AUTHORIZE ANNEXATION OF CERTAIN TERRITORY TO THE VILLAGE OF
BEXLEY, FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO.

Be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Bexley, State of
Ohio:-

SECTION 1. That the annexation of the following
described territory;

Beginning at a point in the north line of Livingston
Avenue Free Pike and the south-east corner of the present corpor-
ate boundaries of the Village of Bexley; thence east with the
north line of said pike to the east line of Marion Township;
thence north with the east line of Marion Township to a point Two
(200) Hundred feet north of the north-east corner of Section Twelve
(12), Township Five (5), Range Twenty-two (22); thence west and
parallel with the north line of said Section and Two Hundred (200)
Feet therefrom to the west line of Cassady Avenue; thence north
with the west line of Cassady Avenue to the south line of the
right-of-way of the B. & O. R. R. Company; thence west with said
south right-of-way line to the center of Alum Creek; thence south
with the center of Alum Creek and the meanders thereof to a point
Two Hundred (200) Feet north of the north line of Section Eleven
(11), said point being the north-west corner of the corporate
limits of the Village of Bexley as now established; thence with
the north and east lines of the present corporation boundaries
to the place of beginning; to the Village of Bexley, Franklin
County, Ohio be and the same is hereby authorized.

SECTION 2. That the Solicitor of said Village be and
he hereby is authorized to prosecute the proceedings necessary to
affect such annexation.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in
force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

AN ORDINANCE NO. _____

TO AMEND SECTION 3 OF AN ORDINANCE NO. 141, PASSED JANUARY 9, 1917,
AMENDING SECTION 3 OF AN ORDINANCE NO. 105, PASSED JANUARY 11, 1916
1916, FIXING THE SALARY OF THE VILLAGE SOLICITOR

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, OHIO

SECTION 1. That Section 3, of an ordinance No. 141,
passed January 9, 1917, amending Section 3 of an ordinance No. 105,
passed January 11, 1916, fixing the salary of the Village Solicitor,
be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 3. The salary of the Village Solicitor shall be \$400 per
annum, payable monthly, for the services to be rendered, as herein provided,
~~except for services and advice rendered to the Board of Trustees of Public~~
~~Affairs, for which service and advice such solicitor shall receive the~~
~~additional sum of \$100 per annum, payable quarterly.~~ Said solicitor shall
not be required to render any service to the Village ~~or to said Board~~ in
any litigated matters for the salary and compensation aforesaid, but in case
his service should be required by said Village or said Board in any case
or cases where the Village or said Board is involved or is threatened with
litigation, he shall receive for such services such sum or sums as may be
agreed upon by such solicitor and the council of said Village and of said
Board.

SECTION 2. That said Section 3 of said ordinance No. _____,
passed January 9, 1917, be and the same hereby is repealed.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force
from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

AN ORDINANCE NO. _____

TO FIX THE SALARY OF THE VILLAGE TREASURER

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO, AS FOLLOWS, TO-WIT:

SECTION 1. That the salary of the treasurer of the Village of Bexley, Ohio, hereby is fixed at the sum of ~~\$100~~ per year, payable quarterly from and after the first day of January, 1918.
