

An Ordinance # 254
By Wm. O. P. Doolittle

To lay special assessments for the improvement of
Bullet Park Place from the north line of Buxley Avenue
to the improved roadway of Broad Street and to Supplement
Ordinance # 211 passed July 8, 1919.

Whereas an estimated assessment of the cost of improving
said Bullet Park Place has been reported to this council by
the board hereof appointed for that purpose; and
whereas all of the owners of the lots and lands fronting
and abutting upon said proposed improvement have filed with
this council a waiver of the publication of the notice of
said estimated assessment as required by Section 3895
General Code.

Now therefore
Be it ordained by the council of the Village of
Buxley Ohio:

Sec 1 That the assessment of the cost and expense of improving
Bullet Park Place from the north line of Buxley Avenue
to the improved roadway of Broad Street in said village
by grading curbing paving the roadway with brick
concrete, some form of asphalt or some form of treated
macadam, constructing sewers necessary to furnish
proper drainage for such improvement and constructing
water and water connections from the water main in
said Bullet Park Place to the inner line of the curb
on said improvement as reported to the council on the
25th day of May 1920 by the board hereof appointed to
estimate said assessments be and the same is hereby
adopted and that there be and hereby is levied and assessed
upon the lots and lands hereinafter described the several
amounts hereinafter set forth - Viz:

It is hereby determined and declared that each of said lots and lands are specially benefited by said improvement in an amount equal to said assessment.

Sec 2 That the assessment against each lot or parcel of land shall be certified to the county auditor for collection and be payable in ten annual installments at the office of the Treasurer of Franklin County, Ohio with interest on the deferred payments at the rate of 5% per annum payable semi-annually from and after April 1-1920 in the manner provided by law.

If said installments of said assessment are not paid when and as the same become due, a penalty will be imposed and collected as provided by law.

Sec 3 That said assessment in an amount equal to the bonds issued for said improvement, when collected shall be paid into the sinking fund and shall be applied to the payment of the bonds issued for said improvement and the interest thereon as the same shall become due and to no other purpose whatsoever. The remainder of said assessment shall be paid to the Treasurer of the Village to reimburse it for money expended in excess of the amount of said bonds.

Sec 4 That ordinance #211 passed July 8-1919 be and the same is hereby repealed.

Sec 5 That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
