

An Ordinance #255

To straighten and alter a portion of Broad Street  
in the Village of Berkeley

Whereas there exists within the Village of Berkeley  
at the intersection of Broad Street and Drexel Avenue in  
said village a circular paved area known as the Berkeley Circle,  
and

whereas it is deemed necessary by the council of  
said village to straighten and alter said Broad Street  
by extending the roadway of said street through said circle  
thereby making said street a continuous highway through  
said circle from east to west, and

whereas said paved area known as Berkeley Circle being  
a part of the public grounds of said village and subject to  
the control of the council of said village, it will not be  
necessary to appropriate any property for the purpose of  
establishing a roadway through said circle from east  
to west as aforesaid, nor therefore,

Be it ordained by the council of the Village of Berkeley:

Sec 1

That said Broad Street at the point of its intersection  
with Drexel Avenue in said village be and the same  
hereby is straightened and altered as follows, to-wit: there  
shall be and there is established a roadway thirty-two feet  
in width through said circle from the north to south  
for a distance of 270 feet more or less commencing at the  
east curb of said circle and extending to the west curb  
thereof, and the center line of the roadway hereby established  
shall coincide with and conform to the center line of the  
roadway of said Broad Street east and west of said circle

Section 2

That the roadway hereby established through said circle upon  
the line and route aforesaid shall hereafter be improved in the  
manner provided by law.

Sec 3

That no existing driveway or area improved for travel  
around or about said circle shall be vacated or abandoned and  
all such existing driveway or improved areas shall be hereafter  
maintained as provided by law.

Sec 4

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and  
after the earliest period allowed by law.
