

An Ordinance #257

To straighten and alter a portion of Drexel Avenue in the Village of Besley.

Whereas, there exists within the village of Besley at the intersection of Broad Street and Drexel Avenue in said village a circular parked area known as the Besley circle and

Whereas, it is deemed necessary by the Council of said village to straighten and alter said Drexel Avenue by extending the roadway of said avenue through said circle thereby making said Avenue a continuous highway through said circle from north to south, and

Whereas, said parked area, known as Besley circle being a part of the public grounds of said village and subject to the control of the Council of said village, it will not be necessary to appropriate any property for the purpose of establishing a roadway through said circle from north to south as aforesaid, now therefore

Sec 1 Be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Besley that said Drexel Avenue at the point of its intersection with Broad Street in said village be and the same hereby is straightened and altered, as follows to-wit: There shall be and hereby is established a roadway thirty feet in width through said circle from the north to south for a distance of 270 feet more or less, commencing at the north curb of said circle and extending to the south curb thereof, and the center line of the roadway hereby established shall coincide with and conform to the center line of the roadway of said Drexel Avenue north and south of said circle.

Sec 2 That the roadway hereby established through said circle upon the line and with aforesaid shall hereafter be improved in the manner provided by law.

Sec 3 That no existing driveways or areas improved for travel around or about said circle shall be vacated or abandoned and all such existing driveways or improved areas shall be hereafter maintained as provided by law.

Sec 4 This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
