

Ordinance No. 260

By the Council of the Village of Busby

That section 7 of an ordinance to fix the compensation of bond of the officers, clerks and employees of the Village of Busby, Ill. as amended on the 25th day of May 1920

Be it ordained by the council of the Village of Busby Ill. as follows to-wit:

Section 1 That section 7 of the ordinance to fix the compensation of bond of the officers, clerks and employees of the village of Busby, Ill. as amended on the 25th day of May 1920 be and the same hereby is amended to read as follows:

Section 7 That the compensation of the street commissioner shall be the sum of \$1700⁰⁰ per annum payable in equal monthly installments; that the compensation of the assistant street commissioner shall be in a sum not to exceed 110⁰⁰ per month while continuously employed; that the compensation of common labourer shall not be more than 60⁰⁰ per hour and the compensation of each team and driver employed by said street commissioner shall not be more than 9⁰⁰ per hour; that said street commissioner shall give bond in the sum of \$500⁰⁰

Section 2 That section 7 of ordinance # 243 to fix the compensation and bond of the officers, clerks, and employees of said village as amended on the 25th day of May 1920 be and the same hereby is repealed.

Section 3 This ordinance should take effect and be in force from and after the 31st day of December 1920
