

An Ordinance #163

To provide for the issue of Bonds in anticipation of the collection of special assessments for the improvement of Dawson Avenue from Fair Avenue to the improved roadway of Broad Street.

Be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Bondy:

State of Ohio

Secton 1 That bonds of said village shall be issued in the aggregate amount of \$6,900.00 for the purpose of raising money in anticipation of collection of special assessments to pay for the improvement of Dawson Avenue from Fair Avenue to the improved roadway of Broad Street in said village, by grading, curbing, paving the roadway with brick, concrete, bituminous asphalt or some form of treated macadam and constructing the sewers necessary to furnish proper drainage for such improvement and constructing water and sewer connections from the water main to sanitary sewer in said Dawson Avenue to the inner line of the curb in pursuance of ordinance #162 passed the 14th day of October 1919.

Secton 2 That said bonds shall be signed by the mayor and the clerk of said village and shall bear the date of October 1, 1930. They shall be of the denomination of \$100.00 each, numbered from 1-161, both inclusive and shall become due and payable on the first day of October, 1930. They shall bear interest at the rate of six per cent (6%) per annum (January 1st) annually on the first day of October and April of each year, for which purpose interest coupons, bearing a facsimile of the signature of the village clerk shall be attached and made part of the said bond. Both principal and interest shall be paid all at the office of the Treasurer of said village.

Secton 3 Said bonds shall be full general obligations of said village and for the payment of the principal and the interest thereon full faith and credit, and the resources of said village shall be and hereby are pledged.

Secton 4 That the council of said village shall levy and collect annually during the term of said bonds, a tax upon all the real and personal property in said village in an amount sufficient to pay the interest on said bonds and provide a sinking fund for their final redemption at maturity, and to provide for the payment of any deficiency in the payment or collection of the assessments as they shall fall due, in anticipation of which said bonds are issued.

Section 5

That said bonds shall express upon them for what the purpose
for which they are issued, and that they are issued in
pursuance of this ordinance; and the Finance Committee of this
Council be and hereby is directed to have said bonds properly prepared
and executed and sell the same according to law, and deposit
the proceeds in the village treasury in a fund to be
designated as "Dawson Avenue Improvement Fund" for the
purpose of paying the cost of said improvement and for which
purpose said money is hereby appropriated.

Section 6

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from
and after the earliest period allowed by law.
