

## Ordinance # 164

Determining to proceed with the Improvement of  
Inclair Ave. from Main Street to Livingston Ave.

Be it ordained, by the council of the Village of Bayley  
State of Ohio, to-wit:

Section 1 That it is hereby determined to proceed with the  
improvement of Inclair Avenue in said village from  
Main Street to Livingston Avenue by grading, curbing and  
paving the roadway with brick, asphalt, bituminous, tar or  
concrete or some other form of permanent improvement,  
constructing sewers necessary for proper drainage for said  
improvement, laying water mains in said Inclair Avenue  
and making water connections to the lots and lands  
fronting and abutting thereon in accordance with the plans  
specifications, estimates and profiles of said project improvement  
heretofore approved and now on file in the office  
of clerk of said village and in pursuance of the resolution  
declaring it necessary to improve said Avenue adopted  
by the Council of said village on the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of August 1920

Section 2 That all claims for damages resulting from such  
improvement shall be judicially inquired into after the  
completion thereof, and the village solicitor be and he hereby is  
authorized and directed to institute proceedings in a court of  
competent jurisdiction to inquire into such claims.

Section 3 That the whole cost of said improvement less one-fiftieth  
thereof and the cost of intersection shall be assessed  
to the lot frontage  
upon all the lots and lands fronting, bounding or abutting  
upon said avenue between Main Street and Livingston Avenue  
which said lots and lands are hereby determined to be specially  
benefited by said improvement and in an amount equal to  
the cost thereof.

Section 4 That the sum of \_\_\_\_\_ dollars be and the same  
hereby is appropriated from the improvement and intersection fund to  
pay the remainder of the cost of said improvement

Section 5 That the assessment as to be levied shall be paid in ten equal  
annual installments with interest on deferred payments at a rate  
not exceeding six percent per annum.

Section 6 That bonds of said village shall be issued in anticipation on the  
collection of the assessments by installments and in an amount  
equal thereto.

Section 7 That the clerk of said village be and he hereby is authorized and directed to advertise for bids for the construction of said improvement according to law.

Section 8 That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
