

Resolution # 204

Directing the preparation of plans for a sewer district to be designated as Sewer District #4

Be it resolved by the Council of the Village of Berly, Wis.

That the plans heretofore devised for the sewerage of that part of the Village of Berly, Wis. included in the boundaries of Sewer Districts No. 1, 2, and 3 heretofore established, be amended by creating a new sewer district to be designated as Sewer District #4 for the purpose of furnishing sewerage to that part of the village bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of the center line of Broad Street and the center line of Remington Road thence with the center line of Remington Road produced to a point in the north line of Fair Avenue; thence easterly with the north line of Fair Avenue to the east line of Belgard Lane produced; thence southerly with the east line of Belgard Lane to a point in the south line of Main Street; thence westerly with the south line of Main Street to a point in the center line of Rocky Avenue; thence southerly with the center of said Rocky Avenue and the center line of said Avenue produced to the north line of Remington Avenue, being the present south corporation line of said village; thence westerly with said south corporation line to a point when the same is intersected by a line parallel to Pleasant Ridge Avenue and 150 feet east of the east line of said Pleasant Ridge Avenue; thence north and parallel to the east line of Pleasant Ridge Avenue and 150 feet east thereof to a point in the south line of Mount Street; thence crossing Mount Street to a point in the north line of the same 145 feet east of the east line of Pleasant Ridge Avenue; thence north parallel to Pleasant Ridge Avenue and 145 feet east of the same to a point in the south line of Main Street; thence westerly with the south line of Main Street to a point when the same is intersected by the west line of the first alley east of Drexel Avenue produced, as the same is shown on the Plat of Berly Park Addition; thence north with the west line of said alley to a point in the south line of Fair Avenue; thence diagonally across Fair Avenue to a point in the north line of Fair Avenue 250 feet east of the east line of Drexel Avenue; thence northerly and parallel to the east line of Drexel Avenue and 250 feet east thereof to the south line of lot 15, Block 24, Bullet Park Addition; thence west with the south line of said lot 15 to the southwest corner of the same; thence north and northeast with the west line of nos. 15 and 14 of said Block 24 of Bullet Park Addition to a point at

south line of Broad Street; thence northerly with the west line of said lot 14, produced to the center line of Broad Street; thence east with the center line of Broad Street to the place of beginning.

Be it resolved further that the engineers of said village be and they are hereby directed to devise and form a plan for the sewerage of said sewer district #4, showing the size, location, inclination and depth of all main sewers and branch sewers connected therewith and report the same to this Council for confirmation.
