

Resolution # 251  
 By Mr. O. P. Dwyer  
 To approve amended plans for sewer districts in  
 the village of Buxley, Ohio.

Whereas the Council by resolution duly adopted on the 23<sup>rd</sup> day  
 of February 1921 - deeming it necessary to amend the plans  
 heretofore adopted establishing Sewer Districts Nos 1-2 and 3 of  
 said village by adding a new sewer district to be designated  
 as Sewer District No. 4, directing the engineers of said  
 village to prepare and submit plans for such sewer district;

and  
 Whereas said engineers have formed and devised a  
 plan of sewerage for that part of said village designated by  
 the Council in its resolution aforesaid, directing the  
 preparation of such plans, which plans are now on file  
 in the office of the Clerk of said village and

Whereas notice of the completion of said plans have  
 been advertised for more than ten days as required by  
 law and,

Whereas no objections have been filed with the Council  
 to such plans of sewerage.

Now therefore, be it resolved by the Council of the  
 Village of Buxley, Ohio, that said plan for said Sewer  
 District No 4 be and the same are hereby approved and  
 confirmed.

Be it resolved further that that part of the sewers  
 in said sewer district commencing at the main sewer  
 in said district where it intersects the first alley  
 south of Peter Avenue in said village thence easterly in  
 said alley to the alley between Sinclair Avenue and Buxley  
 Avenue, thence northerly in said alley between Sinclair  
 Avenue and Buxley Avenue to the first alley south of Main  
 Street; thence easterly in said first alley south of Main Street  
 to the east curb line of Peter Avenue. Be and the same is  
 hereby designated for immediate construction and that the  
 engineers of said village are hereby directed to make an estimate  
 of the cost and expense of such construction.
