the village of Bexley, Ohio:
That it is necessary to construct a
certain part of the sanitary sewers
in Sewer District No. 4, hereinafter
deccribed, provided for in an amender plan of said sewer districts in
said village, which amended plan

That the portion of the work provided for in said plan hereby determined to be constructed is as follows:
