

Resolution No. 1

Appointing a board to report on estimated assessments to pay the cost of constructing a main and branch main sewer for storm water drainage.

Whereas, it has been determined by Council to assess 75% of the whole cost of constructing a main and branch main sewer for storm water drainage in a part of the Village of Berley, Wis., in a resolution adopted March 4, 1919.

Now Therefore.

Be it resolved by the Council of the Village of Berley, Wis., that, A. W. Zimmerman, C. D. Barnett and J. P. Cook three disinterested freeholders of said village be and they are hereby appointed a board to estimate the assessments of said cost on the lots and lands to be charged therewith as set forth in an Ordinance No. determining to proceed with the construction of said sewer - passed - 1919 in proportion as nearly as may be to the benefits which may result from said sewer to the several lots and parcels of land so assessed and report to the Council the said estimated assessment.
