

## Resolution No 251

Declaring it necessary to improve the first alley east of Parkview Avenue from Carolina Avenue to the right of way of the B. & O. Railroad Company by constructing a water line thereon.

Be it resolved by the Council of the Village of Buxley, State of Ohio to-wit:

Section 1. That it is necessary to improve the first alley east of Parkview Avenue in said village from Carolina Avenue to the right of way of the B. & O. Railroad Company by laying a 4 inch iron water pipe therein in accordance with the plans and specifications, estimates and profiles for said proposed improvements prepared by the Engineers of said village, which are hereby approved and on file in the office of the Clerk of said village.

Section 2. That the whole cost of said improvements shall be assessed by the foot front upon the following lots and lands to-wit:

All the lots and lands bounding and abutting upon the proposed improvement which said lots and lands are hereby determined to be specially benefited by said improvement.

Section 3. That the assessments so to be levied shall be paid in cash to the village treasurer within ten days after the date of the levy thereof upon due notice being given, and in default of such payment the same shall be certified to the tax duplicate for collection as other taxes with penalties as provided by law.

Section 4. That the said assessments when collected shall be used by the Treasurer to reimburse the water fund of said village for money in the sum of \$ \_\_\_\_\_ which hereby is temporarily appropriated from said fund to pay the cost of laying said water pipe.

Section 5. This resolution shall take effect and be enforced from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
