

Resolution 256

Appointing a board to report an estimated assessment of the cost of constructing a sanitary sewer pursuant to ordinance No. 28-1 Passed April 26-1921

Be it resolved by the Council of the Village of Berkeley, State of Ohio that A. W. Ziegler, J. P. Barnett and A. P. Cook three disinterested freeholders of the village be and they are hereby appointed a board to estimate an assessment of the cost less one-fifth thereof of constructing a sanitary sewer in sewer district No. 4 commencing at the main sewer in said district thence in the first alley south of Astor Avenue to the alley between Euclid Avenue and Berkeley Plaza, thence in the alley between Euclid Avenue and Berkeley Plaza to the first alley south of Main Street thence in the first alley south of Main Street to the east curb line of Center Avenue upon all of the lots and lands fronting or abutting upon said improvement including lot number six (6) of Ridge subdivision, in proportion, as nearly as may be, to the benefits which may result from said sewer to the lots and lands so assessed. And report said estimated assessment to this council.
