Appointing a board to report an estimated assessment of the cost of constructing a sanitary sewer pursuant to Ordinance No 287 passed April 26-1921

It is resolved by the Council of the Village of Berkeley State of Ohio that G. W. Sumner, Ed Barneth and D. B. Cook three disinterested freeholders of the Village be and they hereby are appointed a board to estimate and assessment of the cost less one-fiftieth thereof of constructing a sanitary sewer in sewer district No 4, commencing in Sinclair Avenue twenty (20) feet south of Charles Street, thence south in Sinclair Avenue to Livingston Avenue, thence along the north line of Livingston Avenue to a point where said sewer will connect with the main trunk sanitary sewer in Livingston Avenue upon all lots and lands fronting and abutting Sinclair Avenue from Charles Street to Livingston Avenue and lots upon the north side of Livingston Avenue from Sinclair Avenue to the main trunk sewer, in proportion as nearly as may be to the benefits which may result from said sewer to the lots and lands so assessed, and report said estimated assessments to this council.
