

Resolution 259 ✓

Appointing a board to report an estimated assessment of the cost of constructing a sanitary sewer pursuant to Ordinance No. 282 passed April 26 - 1921 and repealing Resolution No. 256 adopted November 27 - 1921. 259

Be it resolved by the Council of the Village of Wesley, State of Ohio that J. S. Stucky, E. Barnette, and J. C. Cook three disinterested holders of the Village be and they are hereby appointed a board to estimate an assessment of the cost less one-fiftieth thereof of constructing a sanitary sewer in sewer district No. 4 commencing at the main sewer in said district thence in the first alley south of Astor Avenue to the alley between Euclid Avenue and Wesley Plaza thence in the alley between Euclid Avenue and Wesley Plaza to the first alley south of main street thence in the first alley south of main street to the east curb line of Foster Avenue upon all of the lots and lands fronting or abutting upon said improvements including lot number 6 D of Ridge subdivision, in proportion as nearly as may be to the benefit which may result from said sewer to the lots and lands so assessed and report said estimated assessments to the council.

Resolved further that Resolution No. 256 adopted November 27 - 1921 be and the same hereby is repealed.
