

## Ordinance #268

To authorize the Board of Trustees of Public Affairs to expend money in excess of \$5000 for the construction of a water line in the alley south of Main Street from Euclaire Avenue to Center Avenue.

Be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Bexley Ohio that:

Section 1 That the Board of Trustees of Public Affairs of said village be and they hereby are authorized to expend the sum of \$2500 dollars for the construction of an eight inch water line with necessary fire hydrants in the said alley south of main street from the water line on Euclaire Avenue to the east curb line of Center Avenue.

Section 2 That the sum of \$2500 and hereby is appropriated from the proceeds of bonds heretofore issued for water works purposes, to pay the cost of the same.

Section 3 This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest print allowed by law.
