

Ordinance # 269

To Levy special assessments for the improvement of Bexley Avenue from Dawson Avenue to Cassidy Avenue and to repeal ordinance No. 205 passed June 10, 1919.

Be it ordained by the council of the Village of Bexley, State of Ohio, to-wit:

Sections. That to pay the portion of the cost and expense heretofore determined to be specially assessed for the improvement of Bexley Avenue from Dawson Ave. to Cassidy Avenue in said Village by grading, curbing, paving the roadway with brick, concrete or some form of asphalt or some form of treated macadam, constructing sewers necessary to furnish proper drainage for such improvement and constructing water and sewer connections from the main and sanitary sewer in said Bexley Avenue to the inner line of the curbs on said Avenue there be and hereby is levied and assessed upon the lots and lands fronting and abutting upon said improvements hereinafter described the several amounts hereinafter set forth, to-wit:

Section 2. That the assessments against each lot or parcel of ground shall be payable in ten annual installments at the office of the Treasurer of Franklin County Ohio, with interest on such payments at the rate of $5\frac{1}{2}\%$ per annum payable semi-annually from October 1st, 1920 after the same has been certified by the County Auditor for collection in the manner provided by law. If said installments of said assessments are not paid when and as the same become due, a penalty will be imposed and collected as provided by law.

Section 3. That said assessments and all portions thereof when collected shall be paid into the sinking fund and shall be applied to the payment of the bonds issued for said improvements and the interest thereon as the same shall become due and to no other purpose whatsoever.

Section 4. That ordinance No. 205 "To levy special assessments for the improvement of Buxley Avenue from Dawson Avenue to Cassidy Avenue" be and the same hereby is repealed.

Section 5. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
