

Ordinance No. 272

To levy special assessments for the improvement of Stanberry Avenue from the north line of Broad Street to the south line of Maryland Avenue, and to repeal ordinance No. 169 entitled an ordinance "To levy special assessments for the improvement of Stanberry Avenue from the north line of Broad Street to the south line of Maryland Avenue," passed October 2, 1919.

Be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Beyley, Ohio:

Section 1. That to pay the cost and expense heretofore determined to be specially assessed for the improvement of Stanberry Avenue from the north line of Broad Street to the south line of Maryland Avenue, by grading, curbing and paving the roadway, constructing sewers necessary to furnish proper drainage for such improvement and constructing water and sanitary sewer connections from the water main and sanitary sewer in said avenue to the lots and lands fronting and abutting thereon there be levied and assessed on the lots and lands herein after described and fronting and abutting on said improvement the several amounts herein after set forth to-wit:

Section 2. That the assessments levied against each lot or parcel of ground as hereinbefore set forth and described, shall be payable in four equal annual installments with interest thereon at the rate of six per cent. (6%) per annum, to be received annually from April 1, 1921, by the office of the Treasurer of Franklin County, Tennessee, the same has been certified to the Board of Education for collection in the manner provided by law.

Section 3. That said assessments and all portions thereof when collected shall be paid into the sinking fund and shall be applied to the payment of bonds issued in anticipation of the collection of assessments for said improvement and the interest thereon as the same shall become due and to no other purpose whatsoever.

Section 4. That ordinance No. 169 passed October 2, 1917,
entitled an ordinance "To levy special assessments
for the improvement of Strawberry Ave. from the north
line of Broad Street to the south line of Mary-
land Avenue" be and the same is hereby repealed.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in
force from and after the earliest period allowed
by law.
