

Ordinance 282

Determining to proceed with the construction of sewers in part of District No. 4 as established March 15, 1921.

Be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Bexley State of O.:
 That it is hereby determined to proceed with the construction of part of the sewers in sewer district No. 4 in said village as follows, to-wit:

Section 1

Commencing at the main sewer in said sewer district No. 4 when it intersects the first alley south of Astor Avenue in said village thence easterly in said alley to the alley between Euclid Avenue and Bexley Avenue thence westerly in the alley between Euclid Avenue and Bexley Avenue to the first alley south of Main Street thence easterly in the first alley south of Main Street to the east end line of Penton Avenue.

Section 2

That said sewers shall be constructed of vitrified sewer pipe and in accordance with the plans and specifications heretofore prepared by the engineers of said village for a system of sewers in said district, adopted by the Council on the 15th day of March, 1921, and now on file in the office of the clerk of said village pursuant to a resolution adopted March 15, 1921.

Section 3

That the cost of said constructing of said sewers less one-fiftieth thereof shall be assessed in proportion to benefits which may result from the improvement upon the following described lots and lands in said district to-wit:

All lots and lands bounding, fronting and abutting upon the proposed improvement which lots and lands are determined to be specially benefited by said improvement.

Section 4

That the assessments as to be levied shall be paid in five equal annual installments with interest on deferred payments at the rate of six per cent. per annum payable semi-annually.

Section 5

That bonds of said village shall be issued in anticipation of the collection of assessments levied for said improvement and in an amount equal thereto.

Section 6 That the sum of \$195⁰⁰ is hereby appropriated from the sum funds of said village to pay one-fiftieth of the cost of said improvement.

Section 7 That the clerk of said village be and he is hereby authorized and directed to advertise for bids for the construction of said improvement according to law, and that the Mayor and Clerk be and they are authorized and directed to execute a contract for the construction of said improvement, after advertisement according to law.

Section 8 That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
